Our Veterans Memorial

This month we are doing two of our KIA/MIA panel enshrines once again. Some of the people we honor on wall number three, the Marine Corps panel information is scanty or non-existent.

Arthur J. Hyde

Arthur J Hyde, was born January 31, 1919 in Houser, Michigan to Mr. & Mrs. Clarence A. Hyde. He graduated from Omro High School and attended Oshkosh State Teachers College for one year before studying at the Curtiss-Wright Technical Schools of California and St. Louis.

Arthur enlisted in the U.S. Army Air Corps on February 14, 1941 and served about 3 years. He arrived overseas in India in October. Captain Arthur J. Hyde was a pilot on a B-29, and was flying on his third mission when reported missing over China on November 11, 1944. Almost a year and a half after he was reported missing, Captain Hyde, 27, was officially listed as dead in a telegram from the war department to his wife, Ruth Hyde. Besides his wife and father, he was survived by a son James Byron Hyde, age 2.

Rex Alvin Loker

Rex Alvin Loker, was born in the town of Omro, on November 4, 1907. He was the son of Fred and Maude Loker. He graduated from Omro High School in 1925 and then worked on the family farm on County Rd. K, until his family moved to Milwaukee in 1926. He then worked at the Marshall and Lisley Bank in Milwaukee until the time he was drafted into the Army in 1941.

After boot camp at Camp Claiborne, Louisiana, he was assigned to the 8th Army Transport Unit in North Africa. He was killed in a truck accident in July of 1943. There were over 18,000 U.S. casualties during the North Africa Campaign.
