CHAPLAINS CORNER

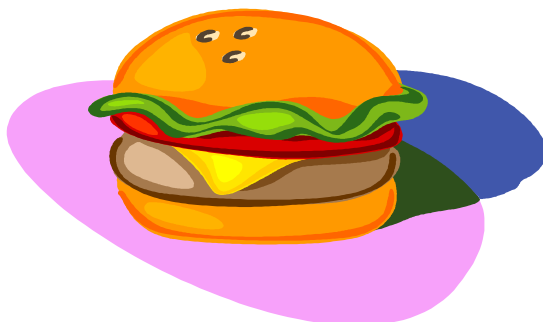
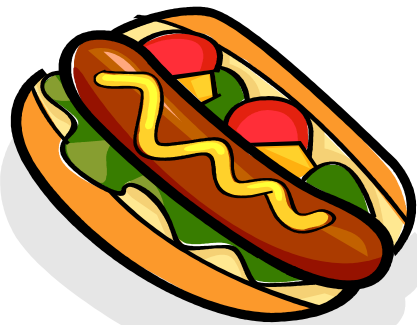
