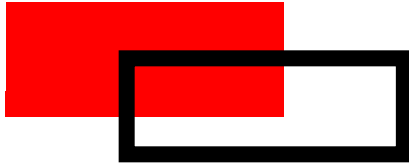

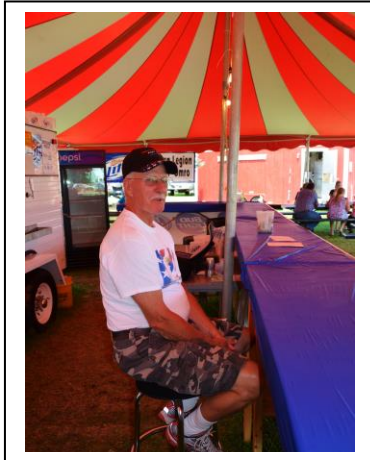
CHAPLAIN'S MESSAGE
