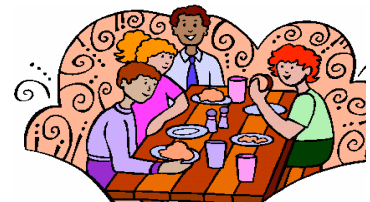

[Legislation Allows Veterans To Salute](#)

U.S. Senator Jim Inhofe today praised the passage by unanimous consent of his bill (S.1877) clarifying U.S. law to allow veterans and servicemen not in uniform to salute the flag. Current law (US Code Title 4, Chapter 1) states veterans and servicemen not in uniform should place their hand over their heart without clarifying whether they can or should salute the flag. "The salute is a form of honor and respect, representing pride in one's military service," Senator Inhofe said. "Veterans and service members continue representing the military services even when not in uniform. I look forward to seeing those who have served saluting proudly at baseball games, parades, and formal events. I believe this is an appropriate way to honor and recognize the 25 million veterans in the United States who have served in the military and remain as role models to others citizens. Those who are currently serving or have served in the military have earned this right, and their recognition will be an inspiration to others."



[Disabled Hunters](#)

Disabled hunters may apply for permits to participate in the special deer hunt to be held at Fort McCoy October 6-7, 2007. Weapons for the hunt are limited to those approved for use during the regular deer season. All participants must possess a Class A or Class C permit issued by the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources and a valid State of Wisconsin Deer Gun license. Permits cost \$10. To receive a 2007 Fort McCoy Disabled Deer Hunt application, call the Fort McCoy Permit Sales Office at (608) 388-3337 or email permitsales@conus.army.mil, Applications are processed on a first come-first served basis. Applications received after August 24, 2007, will be returned.
