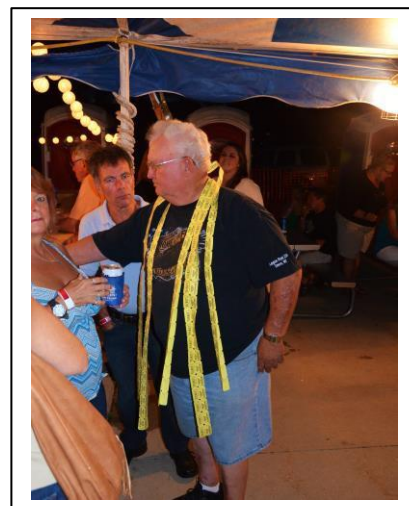
CHAPLAINS CORNER
